Summary of Duties

Applies basic skills and appropriate welding processes to join, surface, fabrication of metal or other weldable materials to assemble structures. Demonstrates proficiency with stick and flux from 3G, 4G and 6G. Consistently meets or exceeds production and safety requirements for assigned projects.

Responsibilities
